



## Johnson City Chamber of Commerce 2020 Scholarship Program

The Johnson City Chamber of Commerce announces their **2020 Scholarship Award Program**. Under the program, one (1) \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a senior attending LBJ High School in Johnson City, Texas.

### Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- \* Seeking a graduating senior with a record of volunteerism in the community in non-school sponsored activities and participation in extracurricular school activities.
- \* Applicants must plan to attend a two (2)-year community college or four (4)-year college or university.
- \* Scholarship funds will be paid during the month of **June 2020**—**directly to the college**, not the student. The scholarship funds will be issued to the college or university upon receiving a certificate of enrollment for the fall semester, which includes the Student ID number and Financial Aid Office address.
- \* Applicants must have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor on their application attesting they are qualified for this scholarship program.
- \* Applications must be received by the Johnson City Chamber of Commerce no later than **April 15, 2020**. Late applications will not be accepted.
